CAMP JUNIPER KNOLL

Camp Juniper Knoll, a troop and summer residential camp, is located in East Troy, Wisconsin, approximately 100 miles north of Chicago. The camp is situated on 186 acres and features boating and swimming on Pleasant Lake, a nature and crafts center, cabins, tent units, shower house and dining hall.

FACILITIES

The Promise Lodge is a winterized unit that can be used by one large or two small troops. Each side (A & B) has a common room for dining and activities, fireplace, kitchen with a stove, double oven and refrigerator / freezer, bunk wing with bunk beds and mattresses and a bathroom with flush toilets and showers.

Wilderness is a winterized unit with a main room for sleeping and activities, a fireplace, mattresses for sleeping on the floor, kitchen with stove and refrigerator and a bathroom with flush toilets. From May through September, platform tents can be utilized, along with an outside kitchen fly, galley and fire scar. Maximum capacity is 36 year round.

Health Center is a winterized unit with a main room for sleeping and activities, mattresses for sleeping on the floor, private bedroom with four cots and mattresses, kitchen with stove and refrigerator and two bathrooms with flush toilets. Maximum capacity is 20 year round.

Citadel is **not** a winterized unit, although it does have a wood burning stove, main room for sleeping and activities, mattresses for sleeping on the floor and a kitchen with stove and refrigerator. A wash stand and flush toilets are located near the cabin. Platform tents can be utilized, along with an outside fire scar. Maximum capacity is 18 indoors or 36 outdoors, May through September only. (The indoor and outdoor capacities **can not** be combined to increase site capacity.)

Clippership is a platform tent unit with an outside kitchen fly, galley, fire scars and has cots with mattresses for sleeping. A wash stand and flush toilets are located nearby. This unit also has a seasonal cabin, for activities, with electricity and two fireplaces. Maximum capacity is 40 from May through September.

Shongela is a Yurt unit with an outside kitchen fly, galley, and fire scar. A Yurt is a circular canvas structure that sleeps 8. There are 4 Yurts on site that have bunk beds with mattresses for sleeping. A wash stand and flush toilets are located nearby. This unit also has a seasonal cabin, for activities, with electricity and two fireplaces. Maximum capacity is 32. Yurts are available year round, but do not have any form of heat in winter weather.

Chalet, Frontier, and Greenwood are platform tent units with outside kitchen flies, galleys, fire scars and have cots with mattresses for sleeping. Each unit has its own wash stand and flush toilets nearby. Maximum capacity for Chalet is 28, Frontier is 36, and Greenwood is 32 from May through September.

CAMP BUTTERNUT SPRINGS

Camp Butternut Springs, utilized as a troop camp, is located in Valparaiso, Indiana, approximately 60 miles south of Chicago. The camp is situated on 304 acres and features a near Olympic sized swimming pool with shower house; dining and program facility, 1 mile track and sports / playing fields; two ponds for canoeing and row boating; an archery field and a network of hiking trails.

FACILITIES

The Friendship Cabin is a winterized unit that can be used by one large or two small troops. Each side (A & B) has a common room for dining and activities, fireplace, kitchen with a stove, double oven and refrigerator / freezer, bunk wing with bunk beds and mattresses and a bathroom with flush toilets and showers.

Beckoning Woods and McCormick are winterized units with main rooms for sleeping and activities, mattresses for sleeping on the floor, cubby holes for gear storage, kitchens with a stove and two refrigerators, fireplaces, bathrooms with flush toilets, and private leaders' rooms with bathroom. Maximum capacity is 36 year round.

Running Water, Hickory, Wieboldt and Trail Tree are winterized units with main rooms for sleeping and activities, bunk beds with mattresses, bathrooms with flush toilets, and kitchens with a stove and refrigerator. Maximum capacity is 16 indoors. ***Running Water, Hickory and Trail Tree*** also have platform tents, which are available from May through September, with a capacity of 36. ***Wieboldt*** also has small cabins, which are available from May through September, with a capacity of 24. (The indoor and outdoor capacities **cannot** be combined to increase site capacity.)
